(3) the contractor shall not use student information, student records and student-generated content for any purposes other than those authorized pursuant to the contract	<p>GoGuardian specifies the limited purposes for which GoGuardian is authorized to use Personal Student Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Product Privacy Policy Provision: <i>How We Use Information Collected Through Our Products</i>
(4) the procedures by which a student, parent or legal guardian of a student may review personally identifiable information contained in student information, student records or student-generated content and correct erroneous information, if any, in such student record	<p>GoGuardian provides a mechanism for eligible students, parents, or guardians to make corrections to Personal Student Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Product Privacy Policy Provision: <i>Your Choices about Information Collected through Our Products</i>
(5) contractor shall take actions designed to ensure the security and confidentiality of student information, student records and student-generated content;	<p>GoGuardian describes the actions it will take to protect Personal Student Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Product Privacy Policy Provision: <i>How We Protect Your Information</i>
(6) procedures that a contractor will follow to notify the local or regional board of education, in accordance with the provisions of section 4 of this act, when there has been an	<p>GoGuardian states how it will comply with applicable breach notification procedures such as Connecticut’s Act Concerning Student Privacy:</p>

<p>(7) that student information, student records or student-generated content shall not be retained or available to the contractor upon completion of the contracted services unless a student, parent or legal guardian of a student chooses to establish or maintain an electronic account with the contractor for the purpose of storing student-generated content;</p>	<p>GoGuardian retains Personal Student Information as directed by the school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Product Privacy Policy Provision: <i>How Long We Keep Information</i>
<p>(8) contractor and the local or regional board of education shall ensure compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, 20 USC 1232g, as amended from time to time;</p>	<p>GoGuardian's EULA contains a provision about FERPA compliance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EULA Provision: Section 3.1("Our Privacy Practices")
<p>(9) laws of the state of Connecticut shall govern the rights and duties of the contractor and the local or regional board of education;</p>	<p>GoGuardian allows another state law to apply other than California law when expressly required by law:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EULA Provision: Section 8.1 ("Governing Law")
<p>(10) any provision of the contract or the application of the contract is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the contract which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.</p>	<p>GoGuardian's EULA contains a severability provision:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EULA Provision: Section 9.3 ("Severability and Interpretation of Any Invalid Terms")
